



How to resize text, image, and video in your browser

You can change the size of text, images, and videos for one webpage or for all webpages in your browser by using zoom in or out functionality. Below are the keyboard shortcuts to zoom in or out.

To make everything larger:

- Windows and Linux: Press Ctrl and +
- Mac: Press ⌘ and +
- Chrome OS: Press Ctrl and +

To make everything smaller:

- Windows and Linux: Press Ctrl and –
- Mac: Press ⌘ and –
- Chrome OS: Press Ctrl and -

To use the fullscreen mode:

- Windows and Linux: Press F11
- Mac: Press ⌘ and Ctrl and f
- Chrome OS: Press the fullscreen (F4) key at the keyboard top

In addition to these keyboard shortcuts, you can also directly use the built-in Zoom options available in your browsers. In Chrome, Firefox, Internet Explorer and Edge, click the button located at the top right. Depending on your browser, this button may be labelled as Settings, Options, More, Menu or something in that nature. Click on the + (plus) and - (minus) signs to adjust. In Safari, you can get to similar settings by clicking the Preferences, and Websites, then click Page Zoom.
